Led by CORMAGDALENA and operated by ONF International, through its branch in Colombia ONF Andina, the PRC was born in the year 2000 with the objective to counteract the erosion of the Magdalena's river banks, through reforestation in cattle farms, combining livestock and forestry activities, seeking to diversify land use in areas converted to extensive livestock in the Magdalena Bajo area and undertaking actions to give way to forestry development in the region.
